DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Must be able to perform, but not be limited to, the following duties and responsibilities:

- Coordinate timely two-way communication between the Maintenance and Operations departments in real time with ACA background;
- Coordinate communication during IROP situations between Maintenance and Operations;
- Assist in a supporting role, the return to service of AOG aircraft;
- Facilitate daily maintenance meetings as required;
- Provide support as required for aircraft operating away from maintenance bases;
- Provide a Fleet Status Report, including ETR's for unserviceable aircraft and immediately advise of any fleet status changes;
- Responsible for the care and control of Company owned publications, tools, and equipment
 by personally ensuring that publications, tools and equipment are returned after use;
- Ensures that any required Maintenance Irregularity Reports (MIRs), Service Difficulty Reports (SDRs), Daily Status Reports and Aircraft Problem Communication Reports are completed properly and entered in systems;
- Work towards achieving true technical dispatch;
- Closely monitor OTP and help to develop solutions for improvement;
- Increase the oversight of tooling and parts for large projects;
- Increase control of Recon equipment;
- Increase in Oversight in GSE status;
- Responsible for OH&S compliance while on shift;
- Other duties as assigned.

SKILLS AND QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must hold valid Transport Canada Aircraft Maintenance Engineers License M1, M2 or E category;
